

COVID Guidelines for HBC

Exhibitors and Guests will be reminded of the following expectations in all communication, and via signage at entrance to each barn:

- Stay home if you are sick or are exhibiting any of the following symptoms – Cough, shortness of breath, fever, chills, muscle pain or sore throat.
- Based on currently available information and clinical expertise, older adults and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions (heart disease, chronic lung disease, asthma, etc.) might be at higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19, and should not attend the Hoosier Beef Congress.
- An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public space where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death.
- Face coverings are required for all attendees. For those who do not bring their own, ISFC will provide face masks free of charge.
- Pen/Stall fans will be required to be mounted high up, pointed towards the ground/animal, to avoid blowing on individuals and between different people.
- Fans will be monitored by show volunteers to prevent from blowing directly from person to person, person to animals, or animals to people.
- Pedestal fans will be set to oscillation mode so that there is no consistent airflow from one person to another.
- A 6' space in front of ground-level fans will be marked off to prevent people from standing directly in front of the airflow discharge.
